Gold Supply Chain Policy

This Policy applies to all employees involved in the processing, refining and trade of gold within AngloGold Ashanti's Brazilian operations.

In recognition of our responsibility to preserve individual human rights and protect against the possibility of significant adverse effects associated with the extraction, trade, handling and export of gold, AngloGold Ashanti is committed to refraining from any action that could contribute to the financing of armed conflict.

Our principles for compliance with the company's Gold Supply Chain Policy include:

- Complying with the guidelines established in our Integrated Management System Policy focusing on incident prevention and the mitigation of environmental, social and economic impacts through the establishment and achievement of technically and economically feasible objectives and targets;
- Fulfilling our ESG (Environmental, Social and Governance) commitments supported by a robust governance framework built on a comprehensive set of policies, standards, and management systems aligned with corporate requirements.
- Do not tolerate and in any way benefiting, contributing, supporting or facilitating practices of abuse associated with the extraction, transport or trade of gold that compromises the promotion of Human Rights and the right to decent work, ensuring that workers' rights to freedom of association and to engage in collective bargaining are preserved and combating child and forced labor as well as any form of discrimination at the company and within its value chain;
- Do not tolerate any direct or indirect support offered to non-state armed groups or public or private security forces performing illegal activities throughout the gold supply chain;
- Recognize that the role of public or private security forces at mine sites, surrounding areas and/or along the transport routes must be strictly limited to upholding the rule of law, safeguarding Human Rights, ensuring the safety of workers, equipment and mine facilities, and protecting mines and transport routes from interference with extraction processes and legitimate trade;
- Require that all private security forces, including by any company operating within the supply chain, perform their duties in full compliance with the Voluntary Principles on Security and Human Rights;
- Do not offer, promise, give, or solicit bribes of any kind and rejecting the solicitation of bribes for the purpose of concealing or presenting incorrect information on taxation, fees and royalties paid to governments for gold extraction and trading rights;
- Ensure that all taxes, fees and royalties related to the extraction and trade of gold are received by government organs.

AngloGold Ashanti immediately adopts the following measures to manage risks associated with the Gold Supply Chain Policy:

- Taking all applicable administrative and legal actions when abuse related to the extraction, transport, or trade of gold are identified.
- Suspending or discontinuing engagement with suppliers, including carriers, within the supply chain where there is a possibility that they are linked to any person, group or institution that directly or indirectly supports non-state armed groups;
- Collaborating, as appropriate, with suppliers, central or local government authorities, international organizations, members of civil society and affected third parties, to combat bribery, fraud/misrepresentation regarding the origin of minerals, money laundering and non-compliance in the payment of taxes, fees and royalties, in order to improve and monitor performance and prevent or mitigate adverse impacts.
